- Coordinates the region's transportation planning
- Federally funded and federally mandated transportation decision making body comprised of local government representatives and transportation agencies

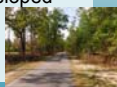

- CRTPA Board comprised of 15 elected officials
- 2 CRTPA Committees – Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and Citizen Multimodal Advisory Committee (CMAC)
- CRTPA Documents include Long Range Transportation Plan (developed every 5 years) and **Transportation Improvement Program** (developed annually)...



Transportation Improvement Program Understanding the TIP

Transportation Improvement Program

- Multi-year document containing transportation projects within the CRTPA region (Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon and Wakulla counties) – State Work Program – state & federally funded.
- Includes roadway, pedestrian, bicycle, airport and transit projects.
- Mandated document (in order to use federal funds \$\$ for transportation projects).



Transportation Improvement Program How are TIP Projects Identified?

- **CRTPA Plans:** Long Range Transportation Plan ("The Regional Mobility Plan")
- **Citizen Involvement:** Project Suggestion (goes into plan development)
- **Agency partner plans:** Tallahassee Regional Airport, StarMetro, Local Bicycle/Pedestrian Plans



Transportation Improvement Program How are TIP Projects Identified? (continued)

- Once identified, projects are annually placed on priority project lists (PPLs)
- PPLs include: Regional Mobility Plan, Transportation Alternatives, Transportation Systems Management (TSM), StarMetro, Tallahassee Regional Airport, Strategic Intermodal System (SIS)

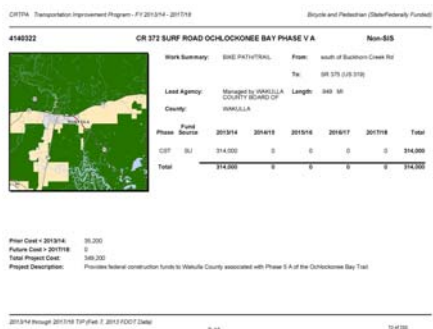

Greg,

Thank you very much for the presentation this evening. I found it very worthwhile and quite informative.

I may have been the only one in the room that was not there primarily for 319 and/or the 319/98 intersection but after hearing comments about those projects, I now have a new appreciation for the problems those areas pose.

But the primary reason I attended was for more information on bike paths. I was very happy to see the Ochlocknee project in the list and was very pleased to see the commitment to bike/ped trails in general. In the 20+ years I've lived in Shell Point, I've seen the road...the only road...in and out of Shell Point resurfaced twice. Each time I was hoping the new resurfacing would include a bike lane...and I was disappointed each time. Being the only route to and from Shell Point and being a two lane road with no paved shoulder with a 35 - 55 speed limits poses quite a safety hazard for a bicyclist. Inclusion of a bike path...even just an extra widening of the pavement to stripe off a bike area...would have been easier in this environment since the road passes through the St. Mark's Wildlife Refuge minimizing right of way concerns.

I know your organization may not be directly concerned with county road projects such as this but I am hoping that there may be some general influence that could encourage counties to incorporate bike paths with resurfacing projects.

Thanks for taking the time to consider this request. Your work to make our region a better place is much appreciated.

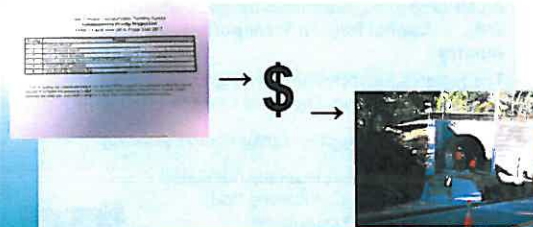

I may have been the only one in the room that was not there primarily for 319 and/or the 319/98 intersection but after hearing comments about those projects, I now have a new appreciation for the problems those areas pose.

But the primary reason I attended was for more information on bike paths. I was very happy to see the Ochlocknee project in the list and was very pleased to see the commitment to bike/ped trails in general. In the 20+ years I've lived in Shell Point, I've seen the road...the only road...in and out of Shell Point resurfaced twice. Each time I was hoping the new resurfacing would include a bike lane...and I was disappointed each time. Being the only route to and from Shell Point and being a two lane road with no paved shoulder with a 35 - 55 speed limits poses quite a safety hazard for a bicyclist. Inclusion of a bike path...even just an extra widening of the pavement to stripe off a bike area...would have been easier in this environment since the road passes through the St. Mark's Wildlife Refuge minimizing right of way concerns.

I know your organization may not be directly concerned with county road projects such as this but I am hoping that there may be some general influence that could encourage counties to incorporate bike paths with resurfacing projects.

Thanks for taking the time to consider this request. Your work to make our region a better place is much appreciated.

Thank you for attending the CRTPA's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) public meeting yesterday as well as your comments related to bicycling near Shell Point.

As you note, the resurfacing of roadways can provide an opportunity for the addition of a paved shoulder where one may not exist. The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) provides some funding for the repaving of county roadways through competitive programs such as the Small County Outreach Program (SCOP) and Small County Road Assistance Program (SCRAP). The projects within the CRTPA region that receive such funding are included in our agency's TIP document. Coordination related to applying for SCOP and SCRAP funding occurs directly between the county and the FDOT. To that end, I have copied Luis Serna and Cleve Fleming with the County's Planning and Public Works departments, respectively.
