#### A. CMAC Bylaw Revisions

The CRTPA Board reviewed the Draft CMAC Bylaws at their March, 2017 Meeting and did not recommend any changes. Since that time, the bylaws were posted on the CRTPA webpage for public review and did not received any comments. The bylaws were scheduled for final adoption at the June 19, 2017 CRTPA Board Meeting, and CRTPA staff was requesting a recommendation of approval from the committee.

Recommended Action: The bylaws received a recommendation of approval without a quorum present. Ms. Pat Maurer made the motion of approval, which was seconded by Mr. JR Harding.

#### B. <u>CMAC</u> Minutes

The minutes of the November 22, 2016, and March 7, 2017 CMAC meetings were prepared for committee review and approval.

Recommended Action: The minutes received a recommendation of approval without a quorum present. Ms. Pat Maurer made the motion of approval, which was seconded by Mr. JR Harding.

#### 3. Presentations/Discussion/Action

# A. <u>Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 - FY 2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)</u> <u>Adoption</u>

The CRTPA FY 2018 – FY 2022 TIP, which contains projects that have received funding in the Florida Department of Transportation's FY 2018 – FY 2022 Work Program, were presented to committee members for a recommendation of approval.

Mr. Harding suggested that the CRTPA include photos of field trips that have been taken to area projects on the CRTPA webpage and FaceBook account. If possible, he encouraged staff to offer weekend fieldtrips to view upcoming or recently completed projects to highlight what the CRTPA does in the community.

Recommended Action: The TIP received a recommendation of approval without a quorum present. Ms. Pat Maurer made the motion of approval, which was seconded by Mr. JR Harding.

#### B. Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 - FY 2023 Priority Project Lists (PPLs)

The following PPLs were presented to the committee for a recommendation of approval:

- 1. Regional Mobility Plan (RMP) Roadways PPL
- 2. Regional Mobility Plan (RMP) Bicycle and Pedestrian PPL
- 3. Regional Trails PPL
- 4. Transportation Systems Management (TSM) PPL
- 5. StarMetro PPL
- 6. Tallahassee International Airport PPL

Mr. Harding made a suggestion that the design and construction of board walking take into consideration the difficulty that misalignment of the boards and points of joining causes those with mobility issues.

Recommended Action: The PPL lists received a recommendation of approval without a quorum present with the inclusion of a comment that trail construction utilize the highest federal standard for accessibility rather than lesser local or state standards. Ms. Pat Maurer made the motion of approval, which was seconded by Mr. JR Harding.

#### C. Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Update

CRTPA staff presented an update of the 2018 UPWP to the committee for a recommendation of approval.

Recommended Action: The UPWP amendment received a recommendation of approval without a quorum present. Ms. Pat Maurer made the motion of approval, which was seconded by Mr. JR Harding.
