

# Transportation Enhancements Workshop

The Capital Region Transportation Planning Agency (CRTPA) is hosting a workshop to discuss the agency's upcoming solicitation of Transportation Enhancements (TE) applications for funding consideration in fiscal years 2013–2017. As the region's transportation planning agency, the CRTPA coordinates the annual submission of TE projects from the capital region (Gadsden, Jefferson, Leon and Wakulla counties) for funding consideration by the Florida Department of Transportation.

TE activities are federally funded projects that expand travel choices and enhance the transportation experience by improving the cultural, historic, aesthetic and environmental aspects of our transportation infrastructure. TE applications may be submitted by community groups, non-profit agencies and local governments.
