



I-10 Interstate Master Plan

For Gadsden, Leon, and Jefferson Counties

Study Purpose

The Florida Department of Transportation, in coordination with our agency partners and public, is initiating the I-10 Interstate Master Plan. The primary purpose of the Master Plan is to develop an integrated multimodal transportation system which is economically efficient, environmentally sound, and moves people and goods in an energy efficient manner. The Master Plan is intended to address the following objectives: 1. Improve the mobility of I-10, 2. Define and analyze conceptual alternatives and 3. Prioritize Right-of-way protection

The following topics have been completed and will be discussed in detail at the upcoming public meetings and at a future Capital Region Transportation Planning Agency (CRTPA) meeting.

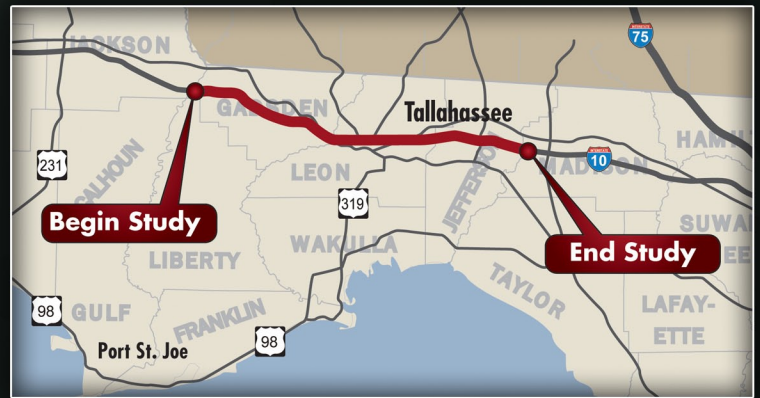

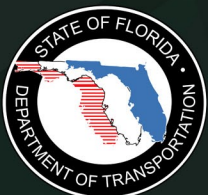
