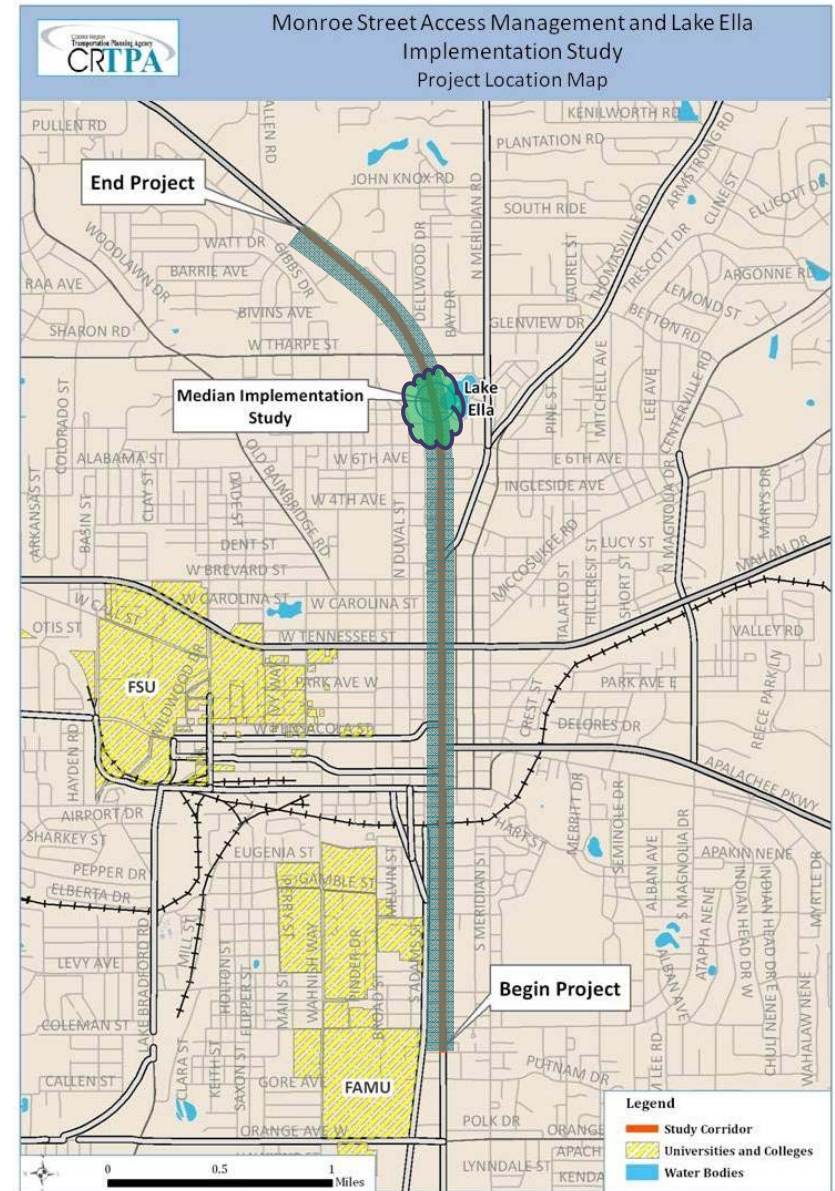

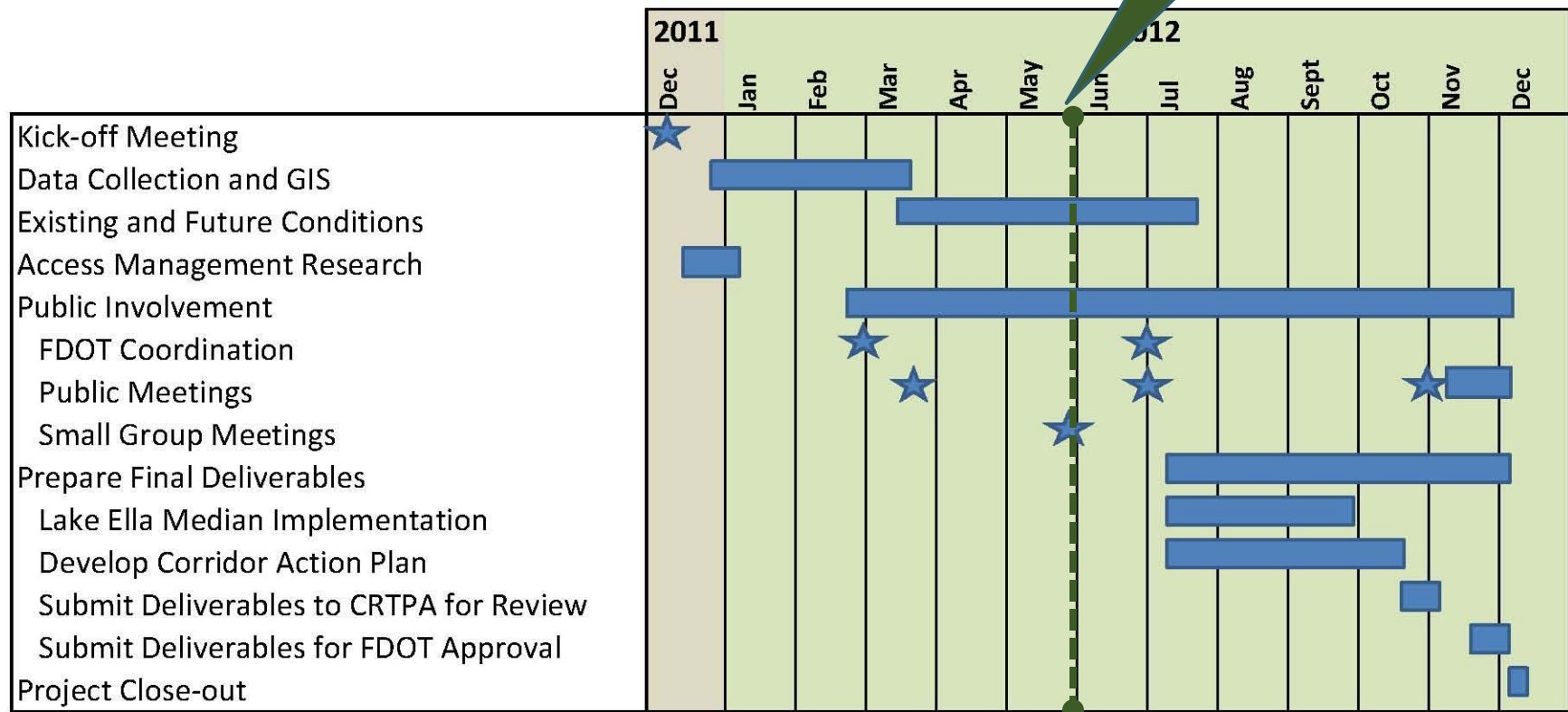


Study Area

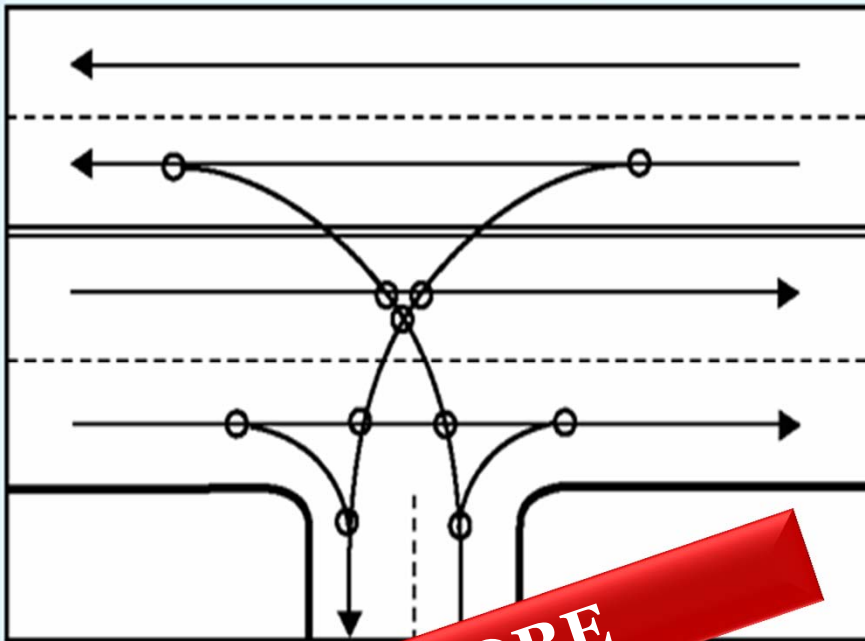

Safety is the Prime Reason for Access Management...

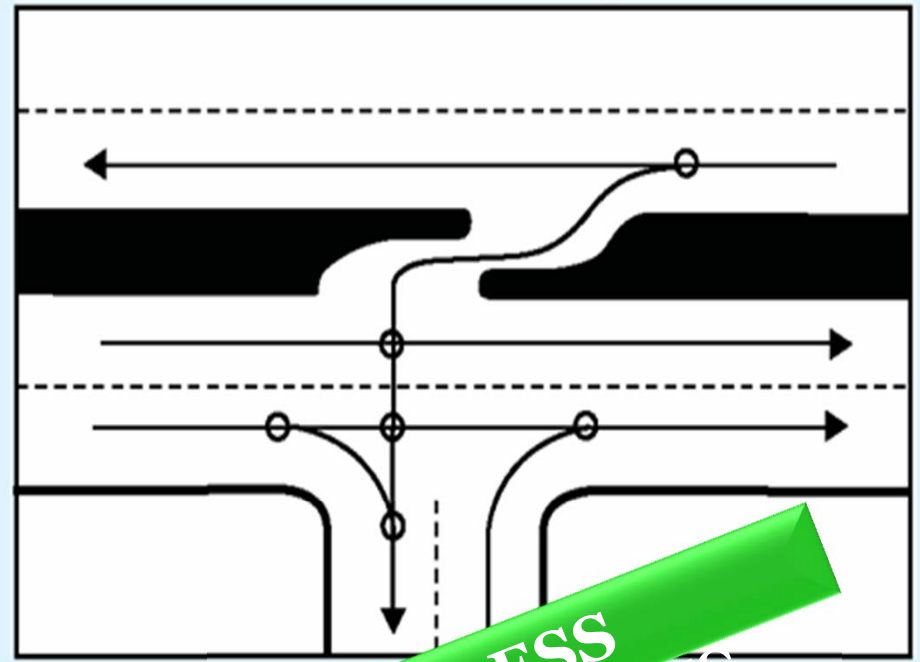
More *conflicts* means more *crashes*

Before Access Management

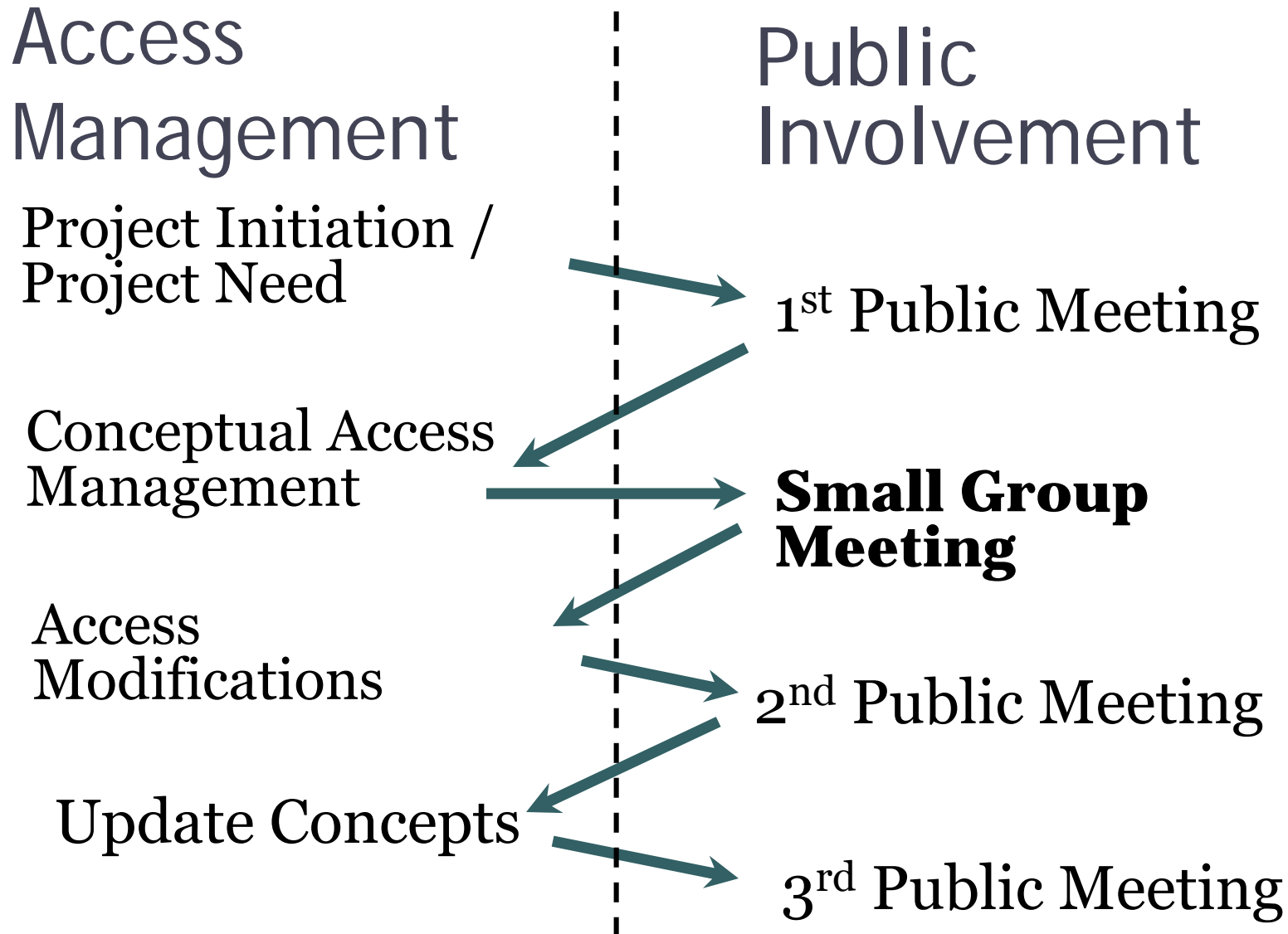

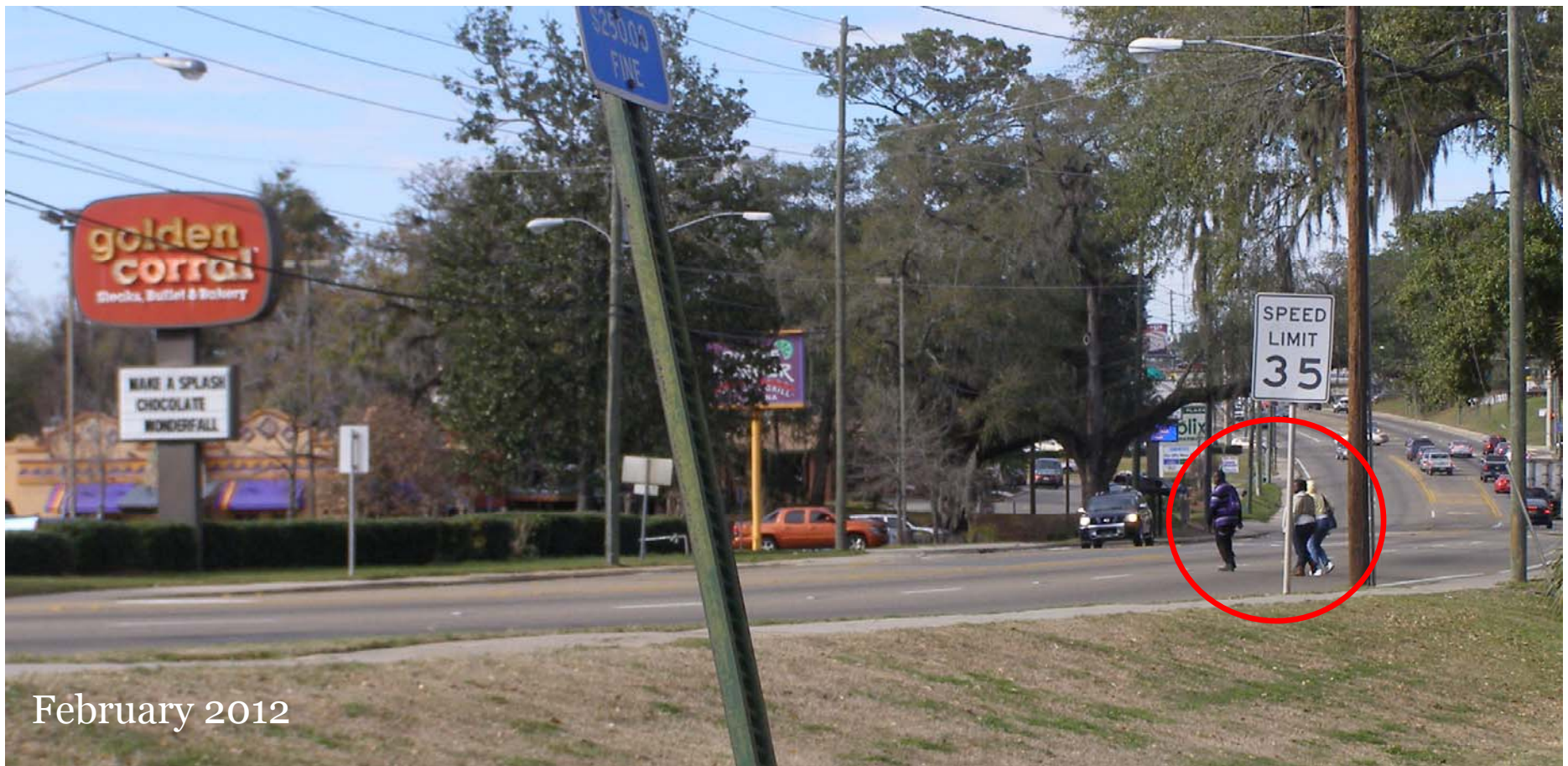
