STATEMENT OF ISSUE

CRTPA SUBCOMMITTEE ACTIONS

The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) and Multimodal Advisory Committee (MAC) met on March 2, 2010, and made recommendations of approval on the following items:

This approval was for approval of the methodology for developing the list and that the list would be brought to the CRTPA Board in March. The subcommittees did not see the list.
- **Regional Mobility Plan Strategies and Scenario Planning Process**
The CAC requested that the Project Team review the presented Strategies and combine the options to form a unified set of Strategies that both implements Smart Growth policies as adopted in the Goals and Objectives and provide measurements to achieve the Goals and Objectives.
